

4-5-10: **EXCEPTIONS:**

Stormwater Retention and Detention Facilities: Stormwater retention and detention facilities shall be incorporated into all developments except where it can be demonstrated that retention or detention facilities are unfeasible to construct and at least one of the following exists:

- A. The stormwater runoff from the development can be directed by natural drainage ways or existing storm systems of adequate capacity to a previously approved stormwater retention or detention facility of adequate capacity to accommodate the runoff by the standards as set forth by the City.
- B. The stormwater runoff from the development can be discharged into an existing drainage or storm sewer system maintained by public bodies other than the City; provided that such other public bodies have evidenced their consent to or acceptance of such discharge.

4-5-11: **ENFORCEMENT:** This code shall be enforced by the authorized enforcement agency.

- A. Any person who violates, disobeys, omits, neglects, or refuses to comply with, or who resists the enforcement of any of the provisions of this Chapter shall be subject to a penalty by a fine of not less than one hundred dollars (\$100.00) nor more than five hundred dollars (\$500.00). Unless specifically provided otherwise, each day that any violation of any provision of this Code continues shall constitute a separate offense.
- B. The violation of any terms of this chapter may result in the posting of a stop work order for the project. If such stop work order is posted, a fee of \$100.00 per violation shall be charged and payable before the stop work order is removed.
