**REQUEST FOR QUALIFICATIONS  
COMMUTER RAIL ALTERNATIVES ANALYSIS  
CHANGE OF CLOSING DATES**

The Tri-County Regional Planning Commission is soliciting Statements of Qualifications from experienced, creative rail engineering/planning firms for two primary tasks:

- Analysis of alternatives for passenger rail service to Peoria
- The development of a feasibility report on the creation of a transit connection (including rail) between Peoria International Airport and the site of a proposed rail terminal in East Peoria

The Tri-County Regional Planning Commission (TCRPC) was established in 1958 to provide regional planning services in the tri-county region. TCRPC provides land use, transportation, and environmental planning services in Peoria, Tazewell, and Woodford Counties.

TCRPC has been pursuing a passenger rail connection for the past several years. A subcommittee of TCRPC, the Passenger Rail Advisory Committee (PRAC) was formally created on January 28, 2010 to provide recommendations to the full Commission. The PRAC has since prioritized a corridor from East Peoria to Bloomington-Normal as the most desirable option for connecting to the Midwest passenger rail system.

The AA will be for a corridor between the CBD of Peoria and the CBD of Bloomington-Normal Illinois along I-74 interstate on the NS ROW

The PRAC and TCRPC are also requesting a feasibility report on the creation of a rail connection between Peoria International Airport and the proposed site of a new rail terminal in East Peoria. This proposed connection would serve travelers to and from Peoria International Airport.

Interested parties are invited to submit statements of qualifications to complete the aforementioned tasks. SOQs should include a description of the services offered, samples of similar work, and a list of client references.

Statements of Qualification submitted in response to this RFQ should be of sufficient length to demonstrate that the respondent has a thorough understanding of the project. However, elaborate submittals are not desired.

Respondents will be evaluated based on understanding of the project, professional credentials, and length and depth of similar experiences. From the SOQs, a selected number of firms will be asked to submit full proposals and participate in an interview process and to respond to a scope of services.
